



Manitoba Band Association 2012 Internship Program



The Manitoba Band Association will sponsor two Manitoba grade eleven students as interns at the 2012 International Music Camp. Interns may attend one of four one-week sessions.

What will I do as an intern? Interns will work with guest conductors and other artist-teaching staff, assist with large group rehearsal management, assist the IMC administrative staff, attend Director's Workshops, and participate in other activities that provide insight into the joys and challenges of being a music educator.

How do I apply? Return the MBA Internship Application by email. Applicants will be selected on the strength of their written application.

What are the benefits? Experience a first hand look at the diverse roles and expectations of music education. Connect and collaborate with music faculty and staff at IMC. MBA will provide about 75% of the fee as an investment in your future. The intern is responsible for the remaining \$100, as well as transportation to and from the International Music Camp.

1. Your name
2. Your email address
3. Your street address, city/town and postal code
4. Your home phone number
5. The name of your school
6. Your parent's/guardian's name and phone number
7. Your grade as of April 2012
8. Indicate whether you have attended IMC before
9. A letter of recommendation from your private instructor or band teacher (must be a MBA member)
10. A copy of your recent report card or grade sheet
11. A 400-500 word essay on why you are interested in becoming a music educator.
12. A list of school experiences, awards and other musical/artistic endeavors that support your application.
13. Your preferred camp week. Rank #1, 2, 3... and indicate if you are unavailable for a certain week. June 17-23 June 24-30 July 1-7 July 15-21 July 22-28

Those selected will be asked to send a \$100 cheque to the Manitoba Band Association.
